Residents Accepted:

Federal and Provincial clients who have been granted conditional release. Potential residents must be willing to live independently and address their Correctional Treatment Plan in the community. 101st Street Apartments provides internal and external programs/services that meet the social and clinical needs of clients with or without mental health concerns.

Acceptance Procedure:

Individuals can apply from their institution by submitting a Community Assessment request through their Institutional Parole Officer to the Edmonton District Parole Office. The request is then forwarded to the Coordinator or Manager at 101st Street Apartments who review these requests on a weekly basis and make immediate decisions.

Exclusions:

Are determined on a case by case basis

History:

101st Street Apartments has been in operation since 1985.

Description:

101st Street Apartments is a Community Based Residential Facility (CBRF) located in a quiet and safe residential area. It is only ten minutes to the city centre by bus and is within easy walking distance to schools, recreation facilities, shopping centers, programs/services and many other amenities. Residents are encouraged to live as independently as possible. The apartments are fully furnished all residents are responsible for their own food preparation.

Programs:

At 101st Street all clients are involved in developing their crime cycle and establishing a case plan to meet their own specific needs.

101st Street Apartments operates:

- The Community Reintegration Program (CRP), which is facilitated by an Occupational Therapist and is designed for clients with a psychiatric illness.
- The CARE Program, which is a three-week intensive personal development program, focusing on aggressive behavior.
- Our staffing model includes a full-time Psychiatric Nurse who conducts weekly clinics with a Psychiatrist in the CBRF.
- The Community Assessment Parole Supervision (CAPS Program) also operates out of 101st Street Apartments. Three contract Parole Officers supervise up to 65 individuals on conditional release and conduct up to 40 community assessments per month.
