Description:

Elpida House (Women) is a Community Based Residential Facility (CBRF) located in a quiet residential community in the north east part of Edmonton. It is located close to major bus routes with easy access to downtown, shopping and recreational facilities. The shared apartments are fully furnished, residences are responsible for their own shopping and food preparation

Short Description:

A community residence for women who are on Day Parole. Elpida House for Women is a program operated by Catholic Social Services. We provide support to all regardless of faith or belief.

Women can apply through an institutional parole officer who forwards the request to Edmonton District Parole. The request is then forwarded to Elpida House (Women) for program staff to review. For more information please contact Dianne Cook.

Staff provide one on one case management and counseling. Referrals are made to the community. Clients are expected to find work or attend an educational facility
